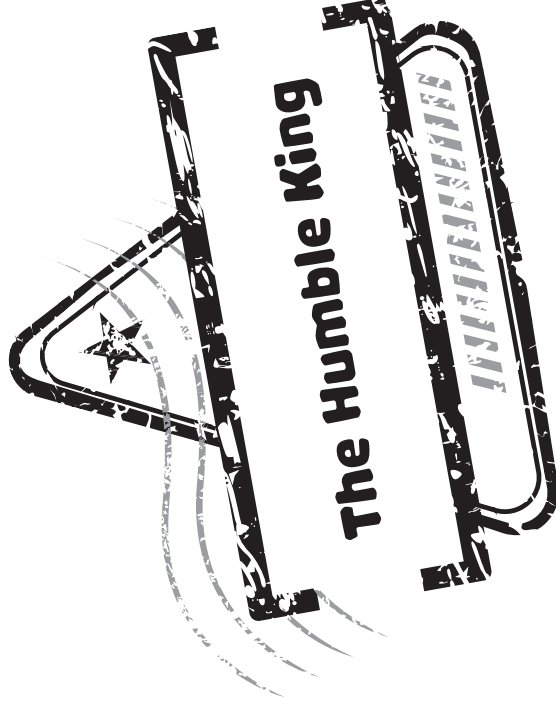


# FIELD NOTES

**Application Verse:**

Read *Philippians 2:9-11* (ICB).
