## FAMILY THEME

The Crucified King

## OBJECTIVES

**Know:** Jesus allowed the full consequences of sin to fall on Himself in our place.

**Think:** Be aware of the extent to which God was willing to go in Christ in our to restore our relationship with Him.

**Do:** Trust in God's ultimate demonstration of His love for us in Christ



## READ: Listen to God

**Read Matthew 27:11-54.** Most of the time, we do what we can to avoid pain. In today's lesson, however, we will see how Christ was willing to experience pain on all levels on our behalf, and as both God and man, allowed the full impact of sin to fall on Him so that we could be free.



## PRAY: TALK to God

We love God because of the love He demonstrated for us by being willing to experience the consequences of sin in our place so that we might have life. Our prayers should reflect our deep gratitude for the extent to which He was willing to go to extend love and grace to us.



## DO: Walk with God

**Option 1:** Jesus, though He was innocent, was arrested, mocked, and eventually put to death. When we see how Jesus was treated, we see what sin seeks to do to all of us. Ask your child if they had ever been bullied, or seen someone who was, and talk about how that was somewhat like the way Jesus was treated. By this, everyone could see what sin really was all about. Jesus suffered the worst that sin could do so that we could be free and know that our sins are forgiven.

**Option 2:** Ask your family the following questions to spark a discussion about pain:

- *What is one of the most painful experiences you ever had?*
- *Which do you think is the hardest to deal with, physical pain or emotional pain? Why?*
